How to get to Körunda

We will charter a bus that will take us from Karolinska Institutet in Huddinge to Körunda on the 8th and back on the 9th. It will depart at 11:00 sharp from Alfred Nobels Allé 8, Huddinge

Travelling by car (40 minutes from Huddinge):

From Stockholm:

Take road 73 towards Nynäshamn. After 45 km turn towards Ösmo, road 225.

Right turn into Ösmo. Keep left, go over the rail way tracks.

Directly after the bus terminal, turn right onto the Körundavägen. Now it is 3km with signs showing the way. Free parking at the premises.

Note! Do not type in Körunda into Eniro or your gps because it will guide you through the small roads in the woods.

Travelling by public transportation:

Take the pendeltåg towards Nynäshamn, travel time approximately 55 minutes from Stockholm central station. Depart at Ösmo. Now it is a 3 km walk to Körunda.

General information:

- There is free wireless Internet at Körunda.
- The surroundings are very beautiful, so take the chance to take explore the area either by running or walking.
- There is a newly built gym, spa, sauna and relax available.
- If you prefer, Körunda also has boule, pool table, Playstation etc.
